We Just wanted to say Thank You! We also wanted to give you our (1) year statistics on our great new home. Judy just loves every inch of it. She likes being in the house and just doing whatever. We still have a lot of work to do on the outside, but we will get it with time.

We have lived in the house one (1) year. We have an unfinished basement and 3,300 square feet of living space. The basement has 2,100 square feet. We keep it heated and shut it off for air conditioning. Our furnace is set up in zones, 3 of them, and that works great for us. We don't have to set the furnace very high around 68 degrees. Because the house is so tight and free of draft, it just doesn't take much to stay warm

We have a gas dryer and water heater. We used 1,000 gallons of propane from July 1, 2001 to April 20, 2002. The price is around 86 cents per gallon. "T and T Propane" is our gas supplier and they do such a good job.

I will list our electrical bill. We keep the air conditioner at 76 degrees when we need it.
